

Hon. Menachim Begin, Prime Minister State of Istael Jerusalem, Israel.

Of course, I am not that naive as to believe that I am in a position (thousands of miles away) to advise you concerning foreign affairs.

However, as a Jew, as a Zionist, and as a former student of High School Hetzelia (Tel-Aviv-1913-1* I'd like (Yes, only would like) to make some observations concerning negotiations Palestinian Autonomy.

First of all, Jerusalem, as a place for those negotiations should never be abandoned.

No way, no way.

Not because it is our Holy City but also because it is the Capitol pf the State of Israel.

There is NO place in the world to replace Jerusalem.

I doubt very much if Mubarak, President of Egypt, is sincere about Camp avid Peace Agreement. If he were he should say to himself "if erusalem was good enough for Anwar Sadat's visit for the sake of Peace, then it certainly should be good enough for Mubarak to negotiate Palestinian issue which is much lesser in importance than the Peace process initiated by Sadat".

The way Mubarak acts it seems he finds excuses not carry out the Camp David Agreement. This is only the first step in that dimection.

I am sure that you are smart enough diplomatically to prevent him from finding other foolish excuses to get out from Camp avid obligations.

Israel, for all the world to see, had carriedout its obligations (regardless how difficult it was) under that Treaty.
Now, let's see if Mubarak would carry his part as well.

As I said earlier in this letter, Prime Minister, my suggestion is ONLY a suggestion. You could take it for what it's worth.

There is another observation I'd like to make. If Argentina would (at the end) take over Falklands from Britain then how much greater claim Israel would have to take over Judea and Samaria, the territory which Jewish people had in their possession for centuries and centuries.

Wishing you the best of health, Prime Minister. Israel and the Jewish people the world over DO NEED YOU.



On behalf of the International Federation of Journalists which represents 103,000 colleagues throughout the world and which has consultative status with the UN, the ILO and UNESCO I want to express our extreme concern at the infringements of press freedom in your country.

In the telegramme we sent you on March 8, 1982, on behalf of the IFJ Bureau, we asked the immediate liberation of three Palestinian journalists, Messrs. Mamoun SAYYED, Ahram HANTYEH and Bachir El BARGHOUTI, who are under house arrest since August 1980 and we expressed our strong wish that they be authorised to resume the exercise of their professional activity.

Since then, we have been informed by press reports about the arrest on March 30 by Israeli police forces who raided the premises of the daily "Al-Fajr" of 18 Palestinian journalists. Among them is the Director of that paper, Mr. Hanna Siniora. The dissemination of "Al-Fajr" and "Al-Shaab" has been prohibited in the occupied territories and their journalists have been submitted to censorship.

As an international professional organisation firmly dedicated to press freedom which includes the right of the public to diversified sources of information, we strongly protest against these facts.

On March 29, 1982, our Israeli affiliate also issued a strong protest against the numerous infringements of press freedom, one of the most important pillars of democracy, and against the efforts of the Israeli authorities to deprive the people of reliable information and we fully support their protest.

Dear Prime Minister Begin:


It is my privilege to submit to you an idea to assure peace between Israel and its Arab neighbors. In my opinion, peace cannot be obtained as long as the P.L.O. prevents Israel or the "moderate" Arabs from arriving at a peace agreement. Just out of fear of trained terrorists, no one will risk his life to come to an agreement. How is it possible then, to eliminate the P.L.O? Definitively not in this generation, where Arab children are brought up with hate, as I myself observed when I visited Hebron last year.

In my opinion, the Arabs not only want peace but need peace, as the Saudis very hesitantly showed the world through a defective peace plan. In order to show the Arabs that Isreal is acting in good faith, Israel should offer COMPLETE AUTONOMY to part of the West Bank and Gaza within 25 years (to the next generation) PROVIDED the P.L.O., or any other terrorist group existing now or formed in the future, refrains from any terrorist attack against Israel OR ARAB STATES LEANING TOWARDS PEACE WITH ISRAEL. For any terrorist attack this deadline will be postponed for five additional years. If autonomy is postponed, it will not be liked by the Arabs involved. Sooner or later, they will stop bankrolling the terrorists and, whether they want it or not, terrorism as we know it might disappear. The Russians sooner or later will realize that their pet project in the Middle East will collapse, so they too will stop contributing to and training terrorists.

Dear Mr. President,

Mr.Z.Hammer, Minister of Education, suggested that I send you some brief information about the activities of IP80.

We are an Israeli foundation set up two years ago, on the initiative of Christian businessmen, who were concerned about the lack of knowledge among Christians about the possibilities Israel's industry has for export.

The main stream of Israeli export goes via Jewish importers to Jewish shops to reach Jewish consumers all over the world. Christians who love Israel are hardly aware of the excellent products Israel has available for export.

The only possibility for Israel to survive in the economic struggle is to double the export in three years.

This is possible if new channels are found. That is what we try. We contact Christian businessmen who have a zeal for Israel and we inform them about the possibilities Israeli products have for them. We get excellent support from Mr. Rami Gutt of the Israel Export Institute.

During these house meetings they give a talk about Israel based on the T E N A C H $_{\bullet}$

The men and women who do this (about 160) are well trained and able to answer a wide variety of questions e.g. regarding Judea and Samaria and presently about the Golan.

Weekly they meet about 2000 Christian families in their homes in Holland, England and Norway.

It is an excellent way of promoting the existance and policy of the State of Israel. The main economic aspect of our organisation is to influence Christian businessmen, so that they will buy as much as possible in Israel.

We make it always very clear that they should only buy Israeli products if they are competative.

By experience we know that this is often the case, although it becomes more and more difficult.
