



As per ASER 2014, 260 million (76%) kids drop out. 52% of Grade 5 students can't read a Grade 2 text or do simple math. In numeracy, 74% of students enrolled in Class 5 could not complete a Class 3 division problem. The relatively well-performing states of Himachal Pradesh and Tamil Nadu ranked at the bottom globally in the 2009 Program for International Student Assessment (PISA) test conducted by the organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD). The assessment measures the quantitative and critical reasoning competencies of 15-year-old students across the world. The two Indian States were placed ahead of only Kyrgyzstan among the 74 participating regions, both in the reading and the Maths assessment.




WHO ARE WE?

Akanksha is a 25 year old organization working towards the vision that one day all children will be equipped with the knowledge skills and character they need to lead empowered lives. Akanksha started with after school centers that focused on imparting quality education to children from low income communities.

In 2007, the Pune Municipal Corporation approached our Board Member and Chairperson of The Thermax Foundation, Anu Aga to partner with them to run Municipal schools in the city of Pune.

Thus, was born Akanksha's first school in the city of Pune. The Project has grown to 16 schools in a span of 8 years and in addition to the PMC, we now partner with the BMC in Mumbai, the PCMC in Pune and the Thermax Foundation.

HOW HAVE WE GROWN?




In 2015, we reached out to 4748 students across two cities through the support of 393 teachers and staff.



WHO ARE OUR STUDENTS?


The students who are enrolled in our schools come from low income communities located in different parts of Mumbai and Pune. A large majority of them are first generation learners who's parents have never had the opportunity to access quality education. Apart from these factors are the rampant social evils such as alcoholism, drug abuse and severe gender discrimination. It is hence not only education we focus on but also the lack of emotional stability, role models and conducive learning atmosphere within which they can excel.




WHO ARE OUR PARENTS?

Our students are the children of household helpers, tailors, rickshaw-drivers and labourers that we meet everyday. Hardship, cramped spaces, lack of sanitation and water scarcity are a reality for them. Most of them have never accessed quality education, making their children first generation learners.

SCHOOL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE (SMC)



All our schools have active SMC bodies that work towards the effective running of the school and serve as advocates of the community.

CENTRAL SMC

The central SMC looks at city-wide issues that Akanksha faces. A consortium of parents from each of our schools form the Central SMC. The Central SMC works closely with the advocacy team to address challenges that are common across the Akanksha network of schools.

HOW HAVE OUR STUDENTS PERFORMED IN THE STATE BOARD (STD. 10) EXAMINATION?


The impact of the model can be seen in the SSC exam results, (as given below) in comparison to the Maharashtra scores.

K.C. Thackeray Vidya Niketan (KCTVN), for the fourth time in a row, achieved a 100% pass percentage and 98% (all but one student) achieved a first class or distinction, a jump from 93% last year.

The highest ranked student achieved a 92.6%, with 15 students appearing on the merit list (over 85%).

In our first English Medium Secondary School in Pune, Acharya Vinobha Bhave School (AVBS), all but one student cleared the exam on the first attempt (97% pass result).

LEADING THE CHANGE?

Our team of dedicated School leaders and teachers enable us to work the way we do. Under their wise and able leadership and practices, our students continue to thrive and outperform every year. Our best practices make our schools a "one of a kind" model.

Our evaluations have always shown that it not only the attendance of our students that matters. Teacher attendance and retention is a key feature of our model.

All new teachers go through a rigorous pre-service residential training program. Once the academic year begins, they are supported with constant feedback, peer observations and best practices are shared through monthly workshops that are conducted by the network support team.
