



Due to my recent injury, I have decided on the advice of my physician to curtail my itinerary to the Mideast and Germany and therefore will limit my travel only to Cairo on the occasion of the U.N. International Conference on Population and Development.

I have long planned to lead the U.S. delegation to the Population Conference in Cairo in September. As you know, population growth and its implications for the environment and sustainable development are issues that are of great concern to me. The Population Conference represents a once-in-a-decade opportunity to advance international efforts concerning population growth. This issue is of such fundamental importance that I find it imperative that I travel to Cairo to present the U.S. views on the urgency of developing an international plan of action to stabilize population growth.

It is my utmost wish that, at the earliest opportunity that is mutually convenient, I will be able to travel to your country and to meet with you. I look forward to that day.




